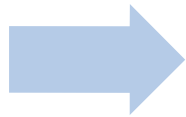

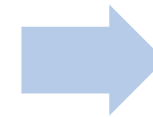

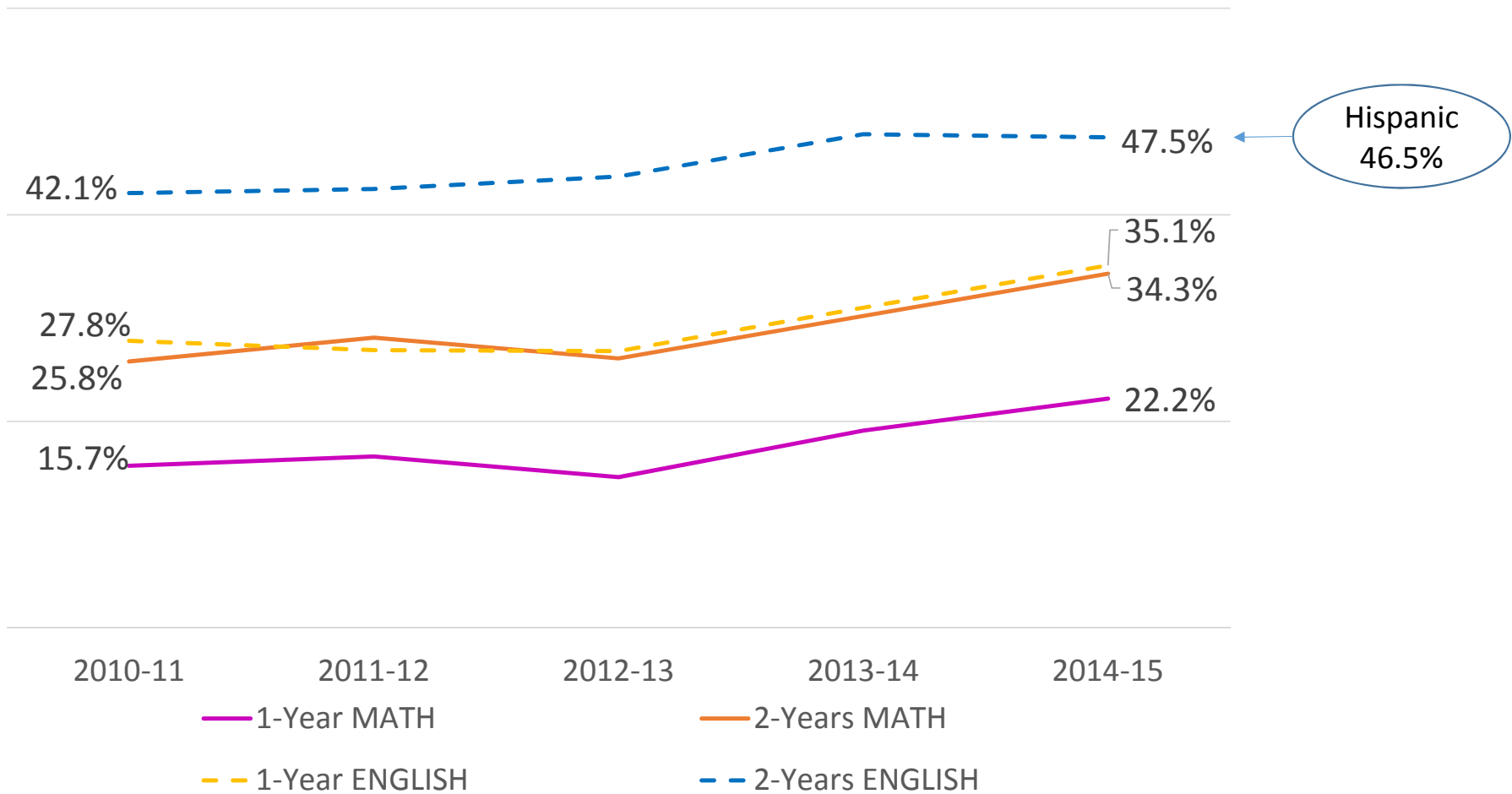

# Transfer Level Achievement Rate

- Cohort of first-time students who complete 6 units and attempt any math OR English in their first year.
- Outcome is completion of a transfer-level course in math or English in their first two years.
- Calculated separately for math and English, also outcomes in 1-year (first year) and 2-year (second year) rate.

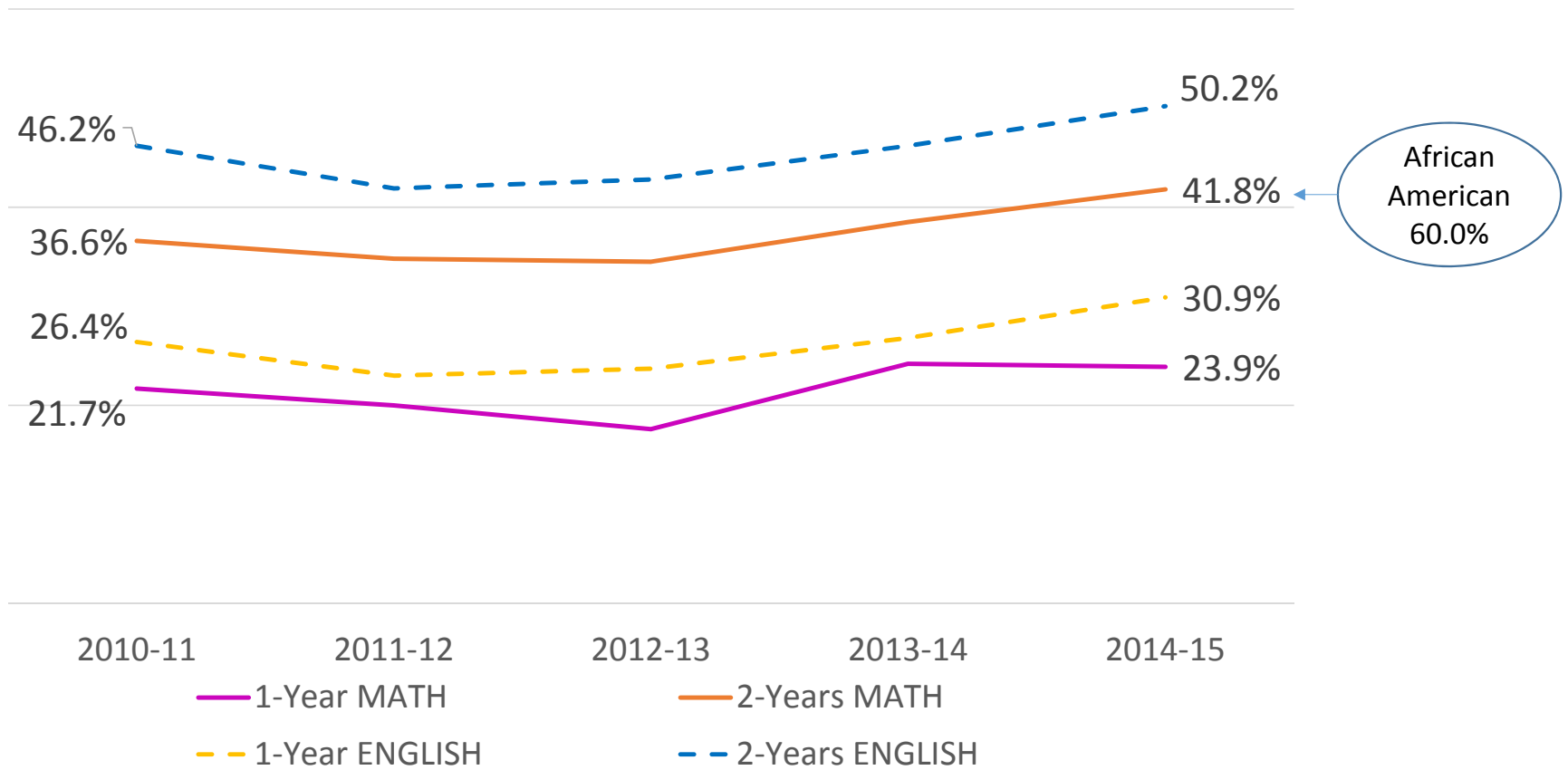


# SJCC - Transfer Level Achievement English & Math



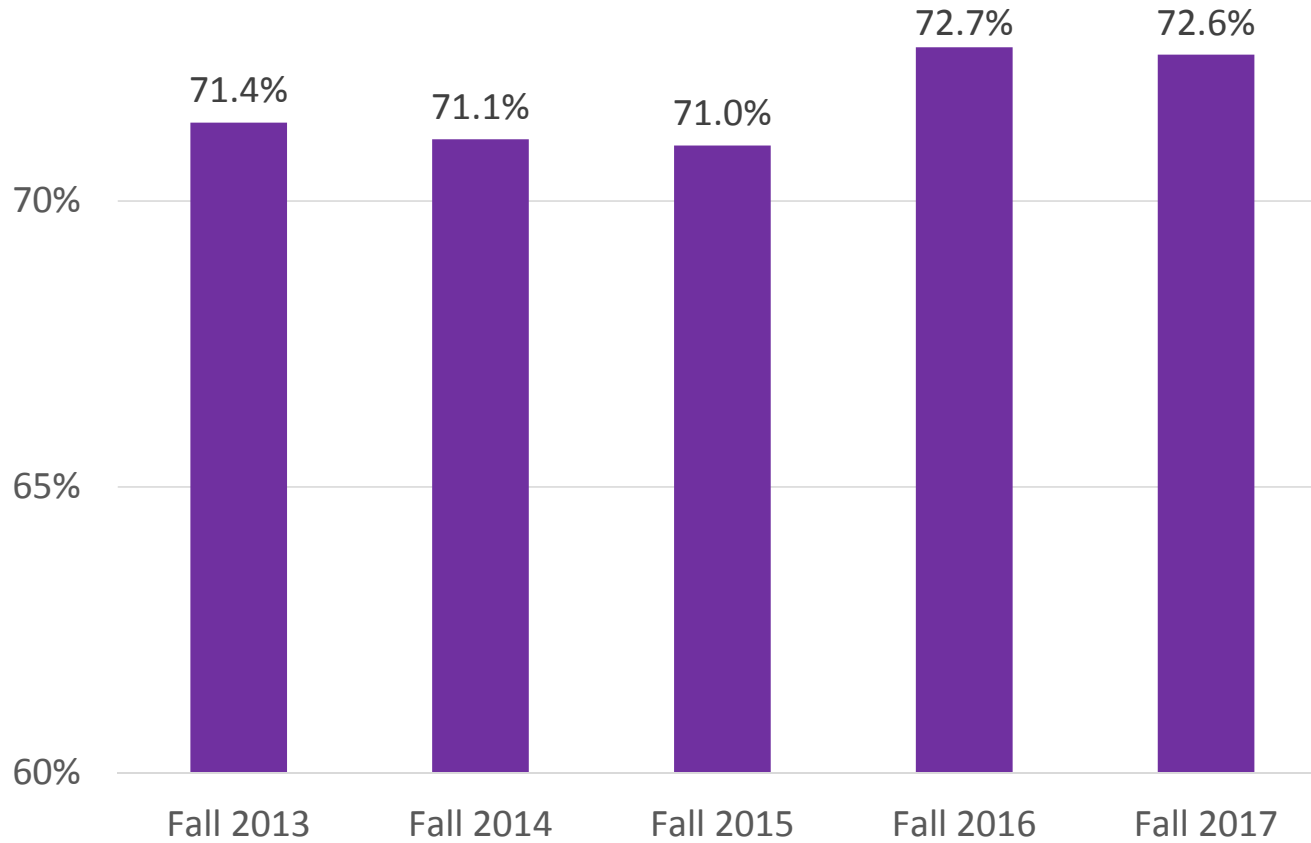


## EVC - Transfer Level Achievement English & Math





# SJCC - Transfer Level Course Success Rate

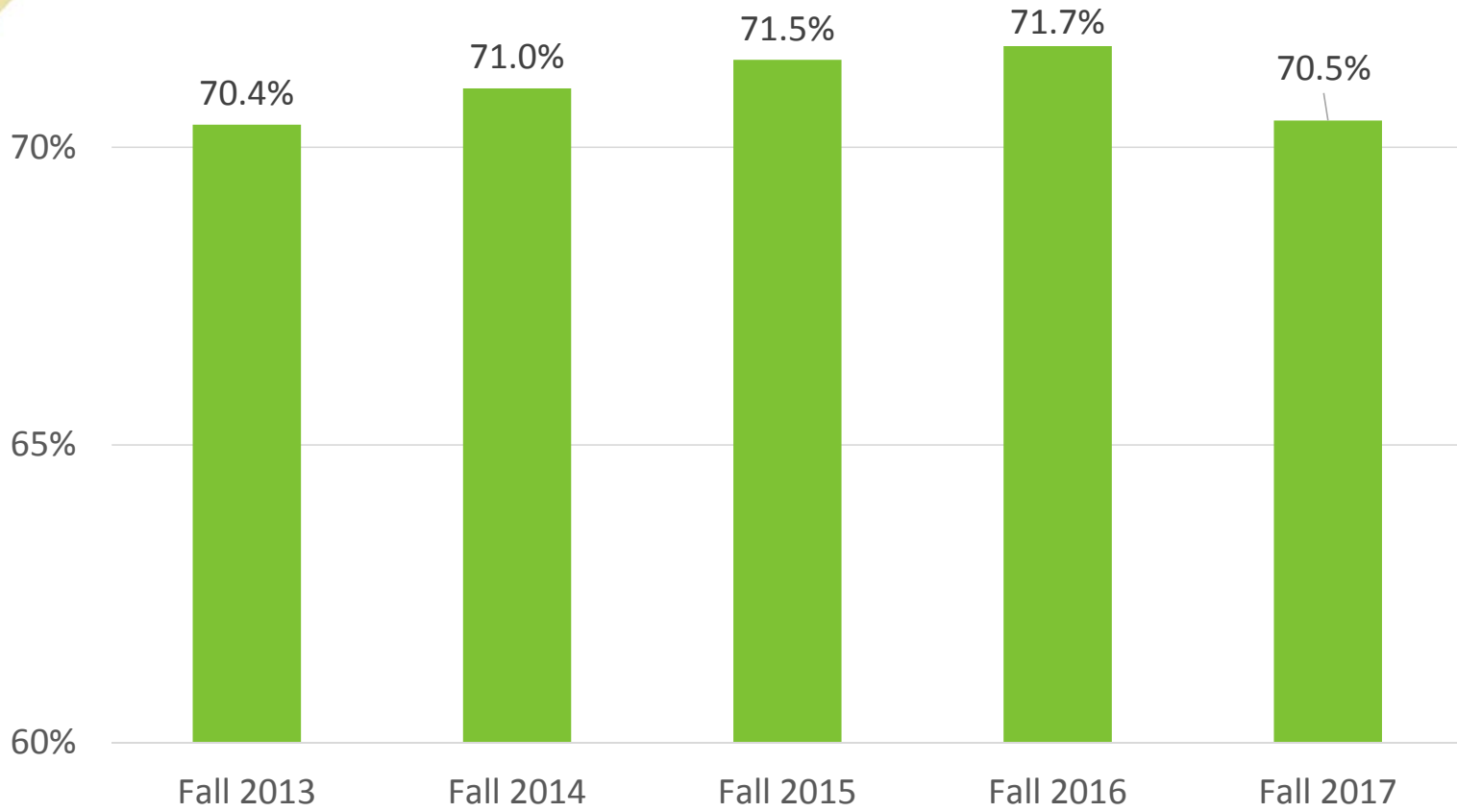

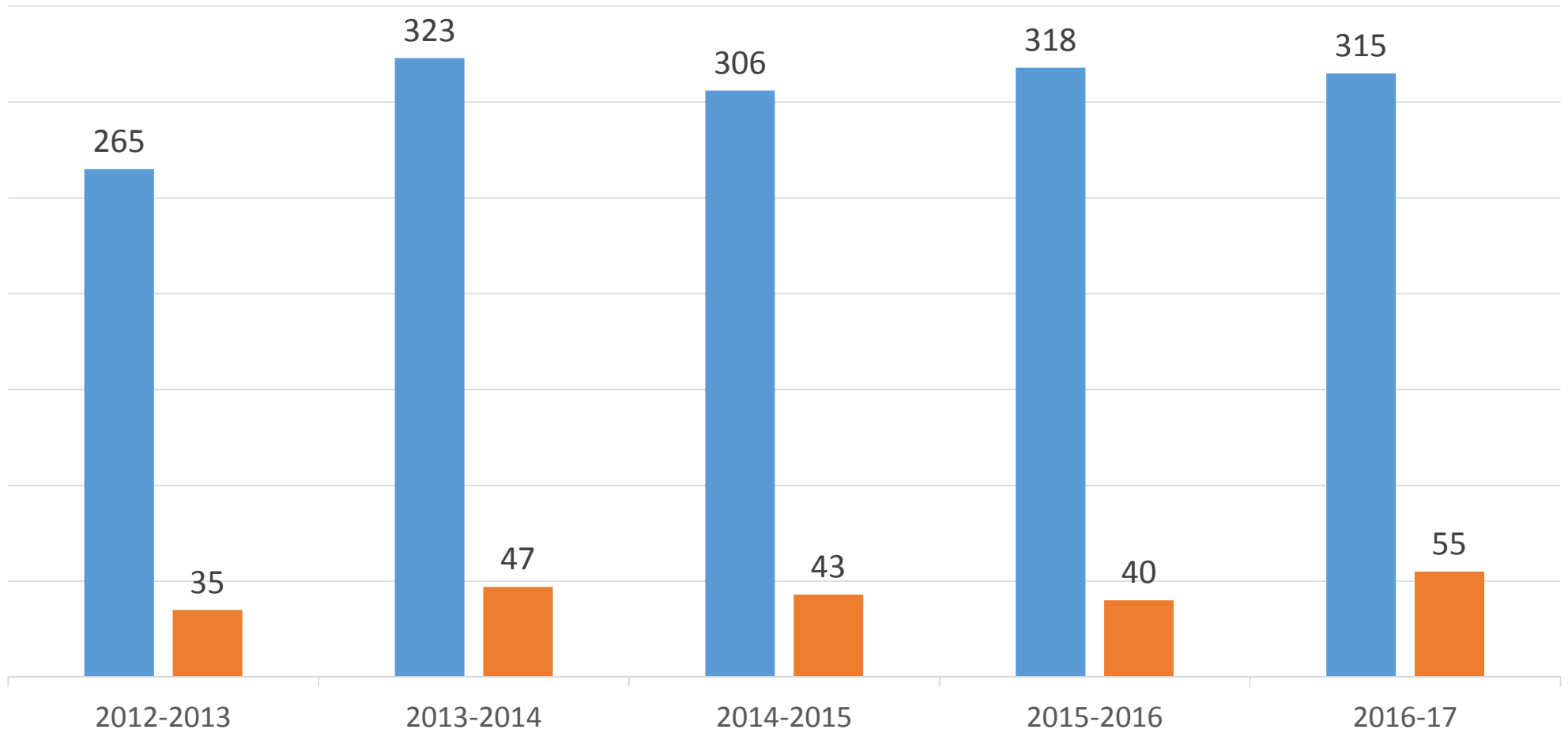


# EVC - Transfer Level Course Success Rate



Rates are higher for all students in special programs CalWorks, CARE, DSPS & EOPS

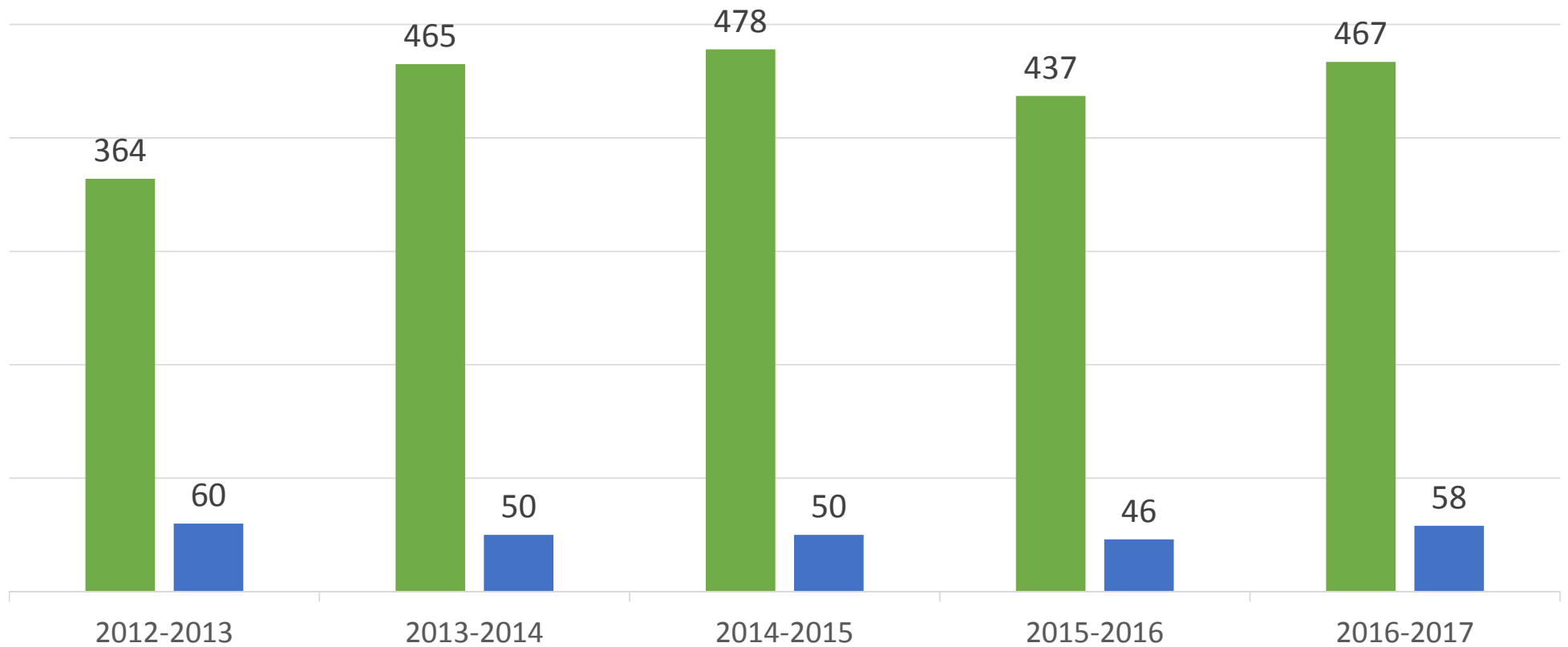
# SJCC Transfers to CSU & UC

# EVC Transfers to CSU & UC

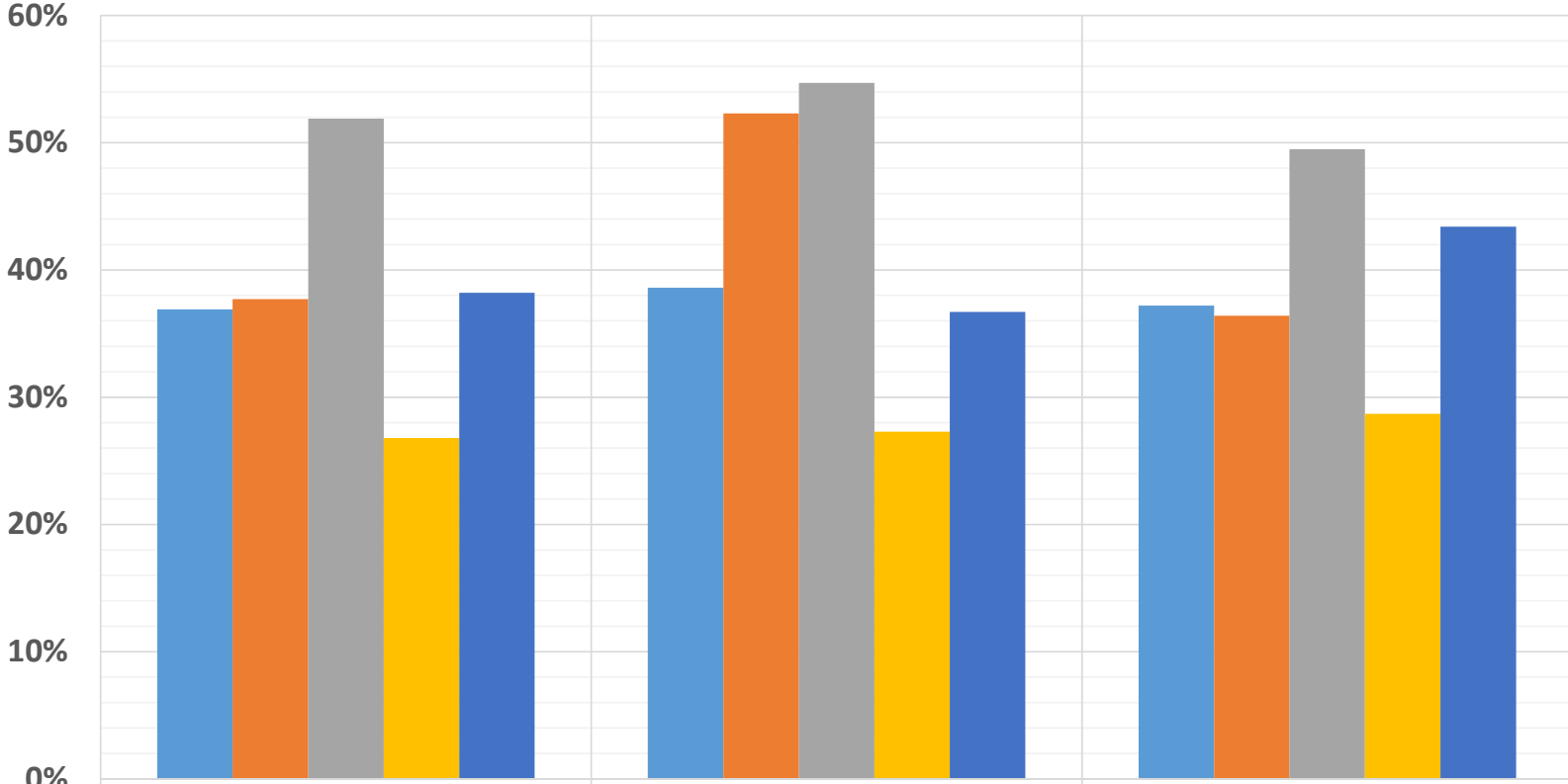

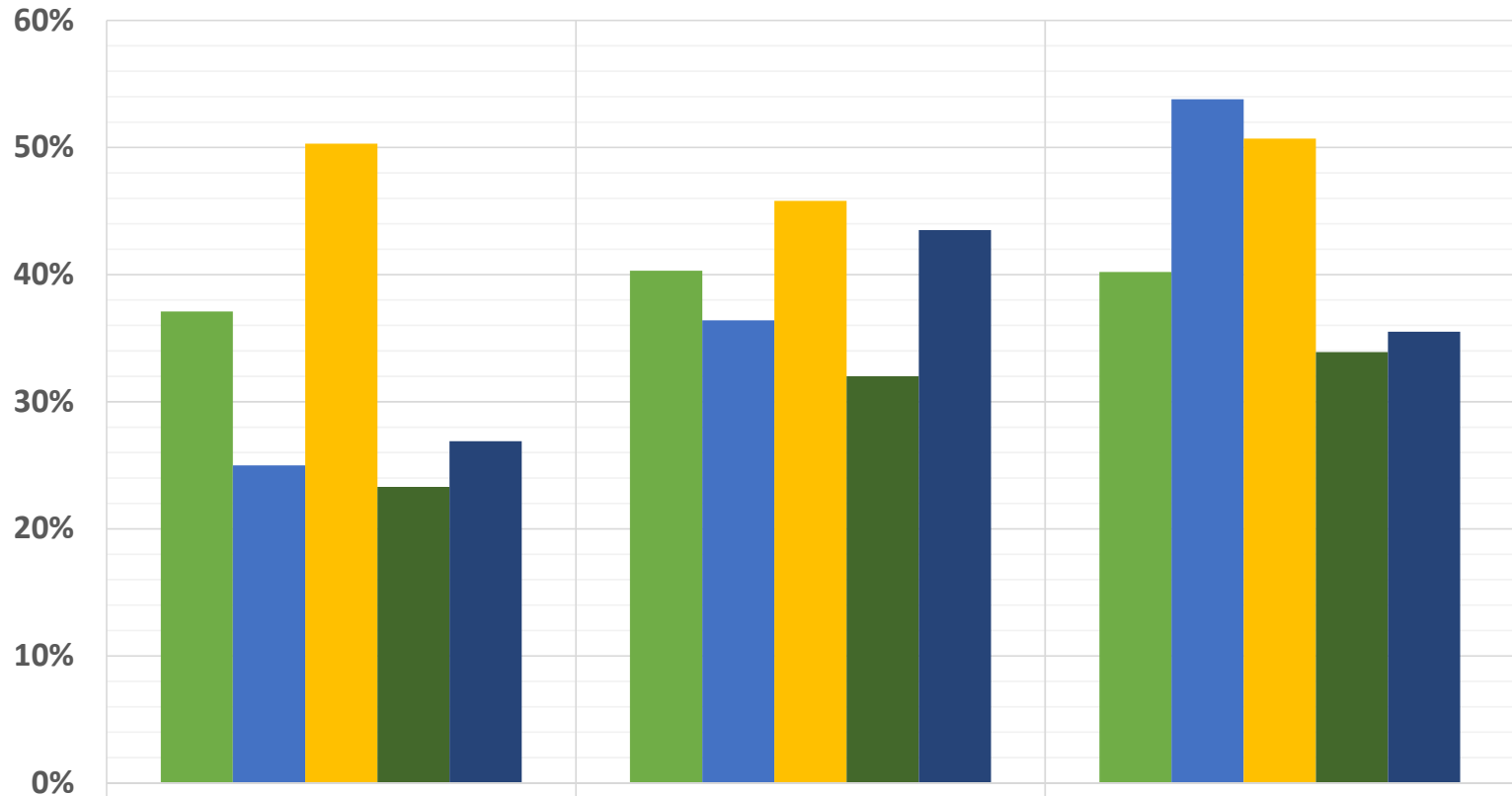
# SJCC Transfer Rate

## Transfers San Jose State University

- As a district, we transferred 523 students in 2016-17 to San Jose State University, an increase of almost 10% from last year.
- Over the past decade, Evergreen Valley College transfers more students to San Jose State University than San Jose City College.
- But, the 10% increase of transfers was evident at both colleges.
- Most popular programs to transfer for EVC students last year was Accountancy, Psychology and Criminology.
- For San Jose City College, students tend to choose Management, Accountancy and Social Science programs at SJSU.

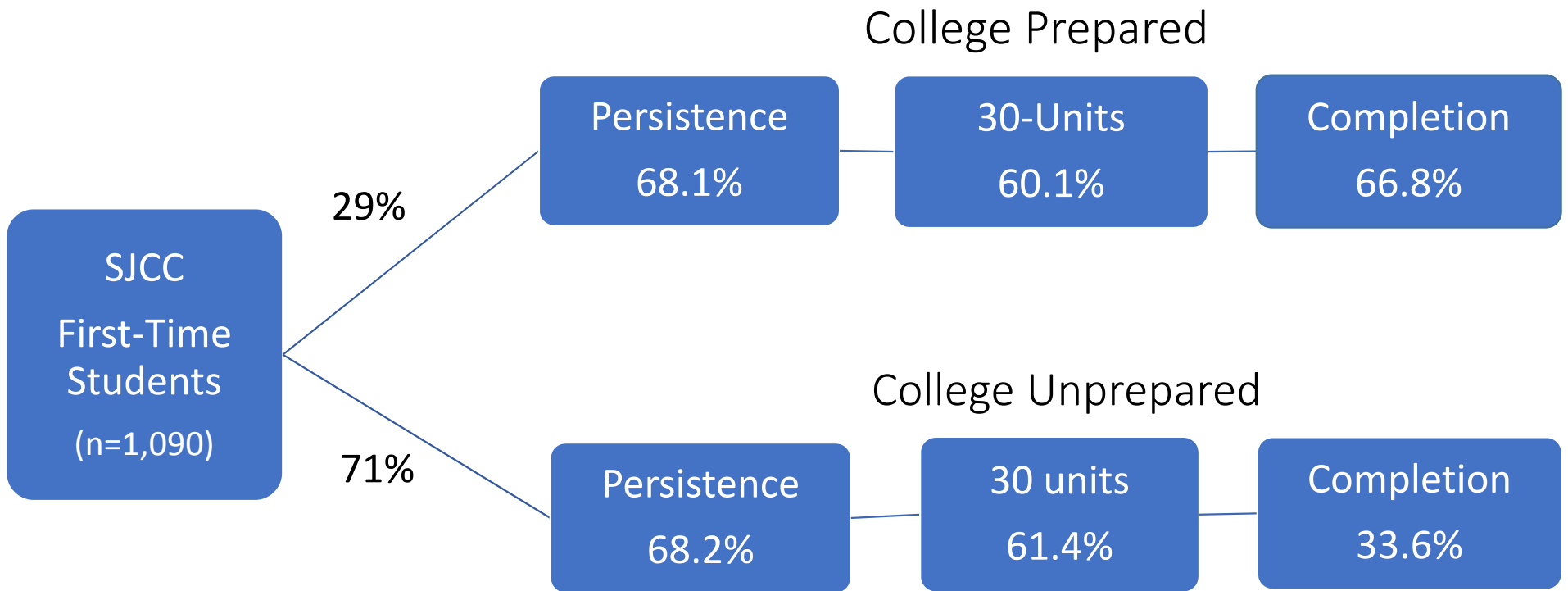

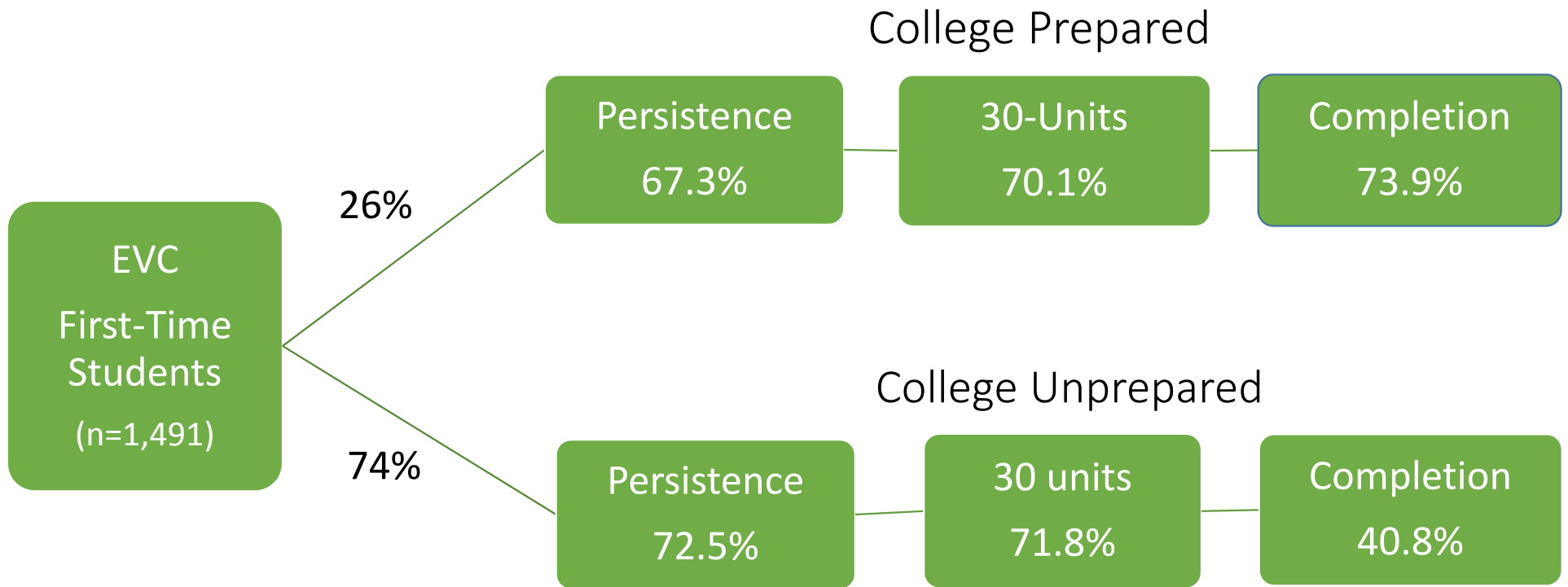

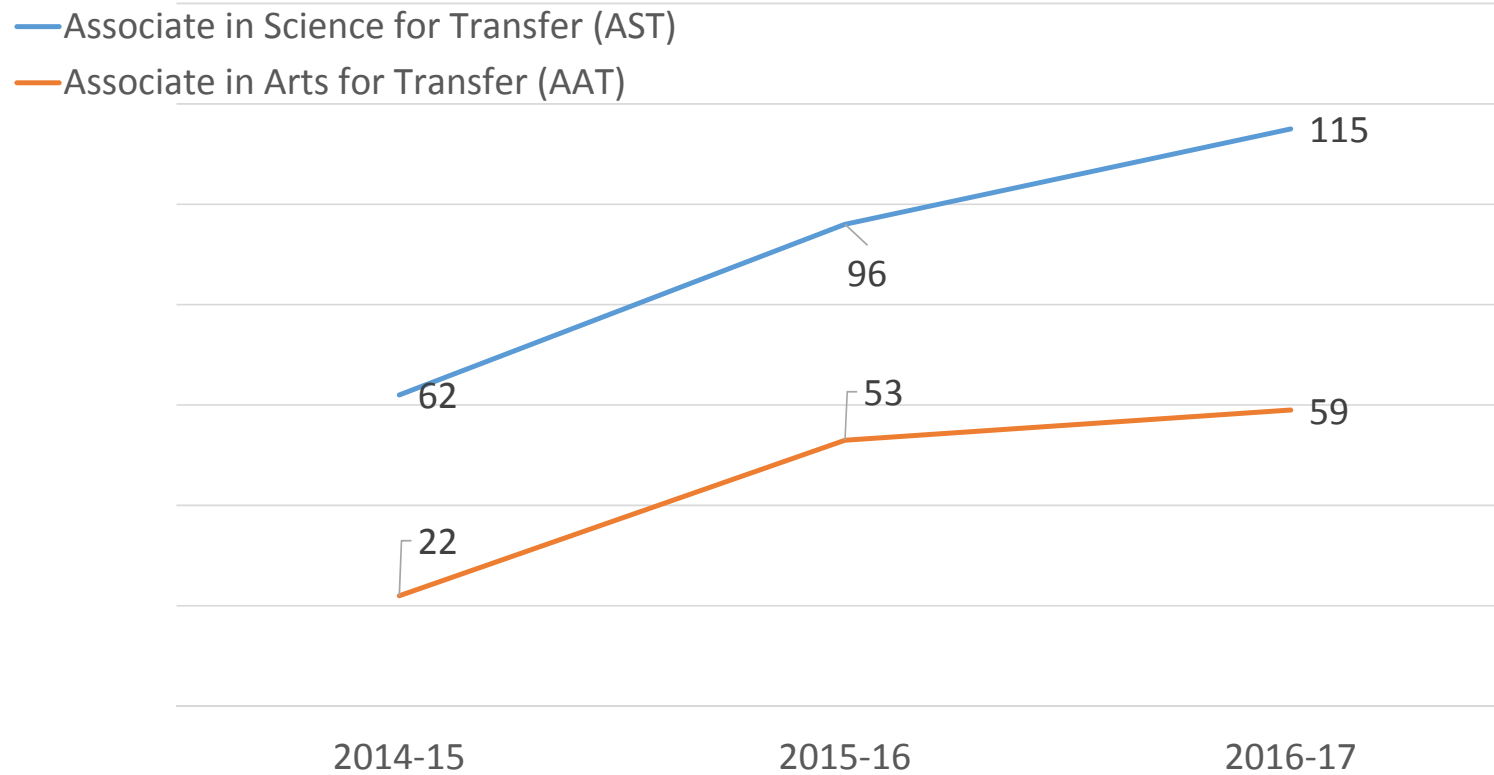

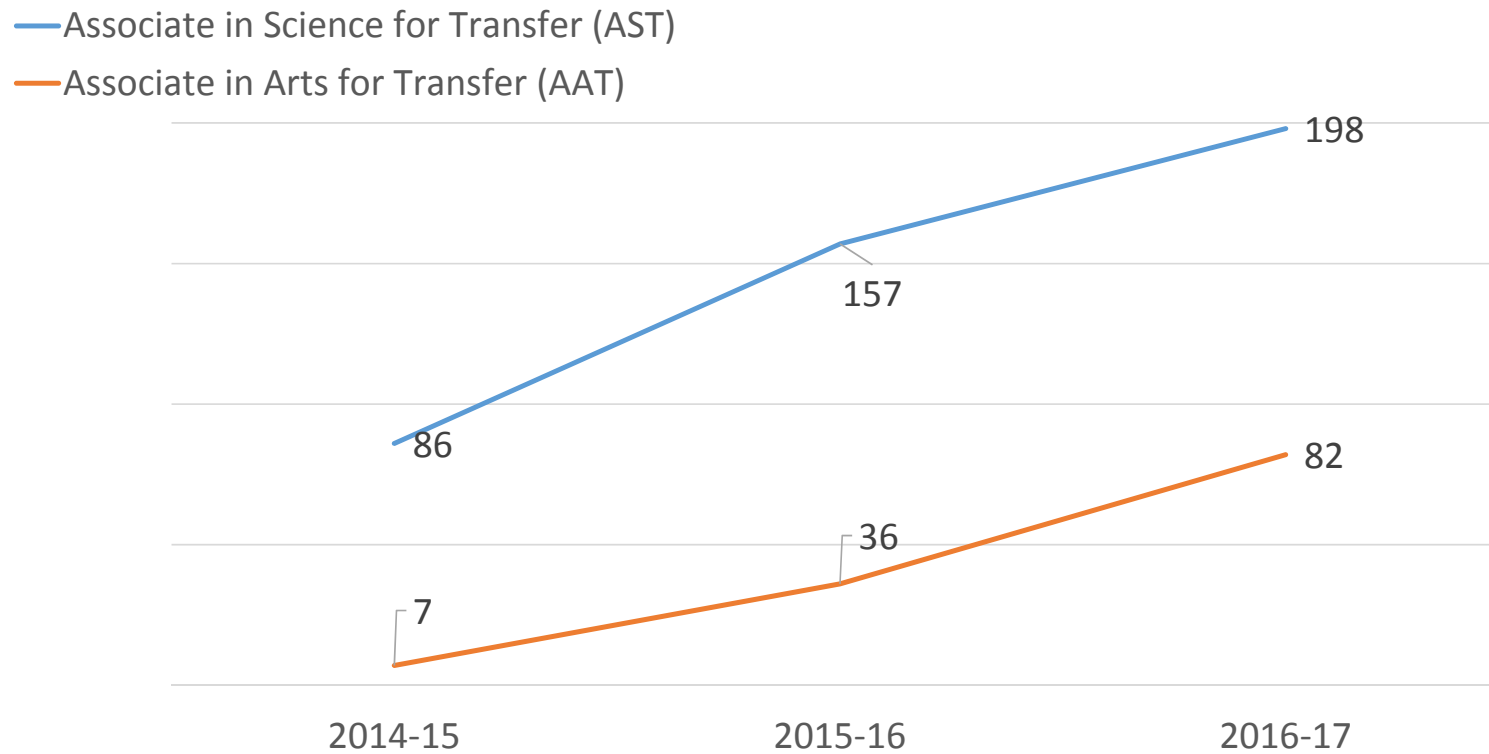
# SJCC - Associate Degrees for Transfer
