## Variance Explanations - Revenues

Total revenues for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2024-25 reflect a \$3.1 million increase compared to the previous year's second quarter actuals, from \$65.2 million to \$68.3 million.

- 1 State revenues comprise 28% of Total Revenues, similar to prior year.
- Local revenues primarily comprised of enrollment fees and property taxes
  - Enrollment revenues are \$9.2 million for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2024-25, \$0.2 million higher than the prior year 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2023-24.
  - Local property taxes amounted to \$53.7 million for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2024-25, approximately \$2.9 million higher from the prior year 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2023-24.
  - County Tax Assessor's most recent tax data point projection from February 7 was an estimated 4.70%.

## Variance Explanations - Expenses

- Oertificated salaries category increased 6.4% when compared to the prior 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. The increase is attributed to the 4% salary increase and filling certificated vacancies.
- © Classified salaries category (includes management) increased 4.5% increase when compared to the prior 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. The increase is attributed to the 4% salary increase, along with filling vacant classified
- positions.
- Benefits increase of 10.8% when compared to the prior 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter.

  Other outgoing is higher by \$1.3 million in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2024-25 compared to the prior year 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter FY 2023-24.
