### **Top Six Priorities for the 2026 - 2034 District Strategic Plan**

#### **Alignment of Plans Across the District**

- Align all Master Plans on a renewal timeline supporting the District Strategic Plan.
- Ensure SJCC, EVC, and District Offices' plans are aligned.
- Provide fiscal stewardship and align resource allocations with planning priorities.
- Consolidate and streamline processes across the District for efficiency.
- Maintain alignment to support stability even through leadership changes.

#### **Strategic Enrollment Management and Addressing Enrollment Drops**

- Develop a Districtwide Strategic Enrollment Management (SEM) Plan that encompasses the two college enrollment management plans.
- Intentionally address demographic enrollment declines.
- Focus on enrollment planning tied to student success and the CCC Vision 2030 equity outcomes.

#### **Strengthen Leadership Stability and Succession Planning**

- Ensure consistent leadership at executive and administrative levels.
- Build professional development and leadership succession planning into strategic priorities and goals.
- Find ways to reduce turnover and keep leadership stable through planning cycles.

#### **Investment in Technology and Data Infrastructure**

- Build a robust data and technology infrastructure aligned to state systems and supported with training.
- Launch a districtwide data dashboard that enables access to uniform reports.
- Infuse technology into operations for efficiency and effectiveness, including enrollment management and administrative functions.

#### **Student Success and Career Preparation Focus**

- Implement services and solutions that support student retention and the timely completion of academic requirements.
- Prepare students for future careers, workforce needs (including work-based learning opportunities), and career advancement.
- Embed student-centered equity and AB 1705, 928, 1111 compliance into student success strategies.

#### **Communication and Governance Infrastructure**

- Develop a Districtwide Communication Plan that integrates college efforts.
- Create a robust participatory governance structure for ongoing, two-way communication between the District Office and colleges.
- Ensure clear expectations and communications are consistently delivered across all levels.
