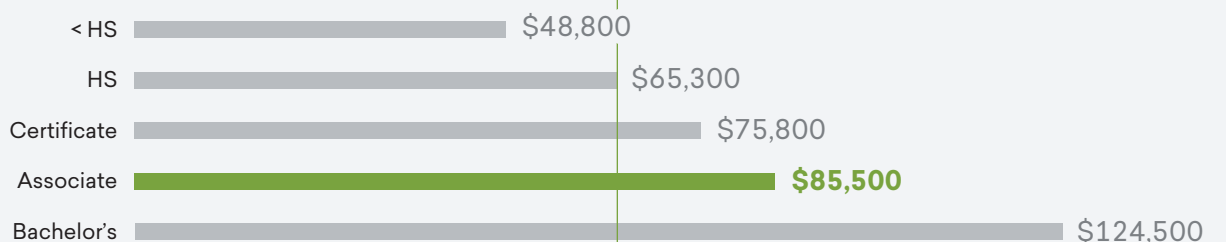

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS
