



Concurrent Planning Efforts

- November 11, 2025 – Board Meeting
 - Board adopts Revised Ends Policies
 - Board adds third Ends Policy on Organizational Effectiveness and Sustainability
- January 14, 2026 – All Administrators' Meeting
 - Purpose: align around a one district lens and to generate strategic planning inputs and outcomes
 - Discussed definitions for student success, community impact, and organizational effectiveness
 - Explored metrics and work needed for implementation
