Student Success, Access, and Completion

- Develop and implement effective, measurable enrollment management plans.
- Fully implement Guided Pathways to streamline student completion and reduce excess units.
- Strengthen and expand dual enrollment programs in collaboration with TK-12 partners.

Student Success, Access, and Completion (continued)

- Close equity gaps in persistence and completion through targeted strategies.
- Support Colleges in revitalizing student engagement through coordinated districtwide frameworks.

Districtwide Alignment, Equity, and Continuous Improvement

- Integrate Strategic, Educational, Facilities, and Technology Master Plans across the District.
- Strengthen cross-college collaboration and unified communication for shared goals.
- Standardize metrics, data reporting, and continuous improvement practices.

Districtwide Alignment, Equity, and Continuous Improvement (continued)

- Embed equity-centered planning and budgeting into all processes.
- Promote open data sharing and transparency to strengthen accountability.

Total Work Environment and Institutional Culture

- Foster a culture of inclusion, collaboration, and collegial consultation.
- Develop districtwide frameworks guiding workload assessment and staffing equity.
- Expand leadership development, professional learning, and mentoring opportunities.

Total Work Environment and Institutional Culture (continued)

- Strengthen Caring Campus initiatives to enhance engagement and shared purpose.
- Ensure consistent standards for onboarding and employee transitions.

Workforce and Economic Development

- Strengthen partnerships with Silicon Valley employers, workforce boards, and universities.
- Reestablish a Workforce Institute to coordinate employer engagement and contract education.
- Support College-led workbased learning and workforce placement initiatives.

Workforce and Economic Development (continued)

- Expand short-term and stackable credentials aligned with labor market demand.
- Advocate for applied baccalaureate expansion where appropriate.

Communication, Outreach, and Community Engagement

- Implement a comprehensive districtwide communication plan, ensuring transparency and feedback loops.
- Strengthen partnerships with TK-12, employers, and civic organizations.
- Expand and diversify
 Foundation funding and alumni engagement.

Communication, Outreach, and Community Engagement (continued)

- Highlight student and community success stories through coordinated outreach.
- Update and share the District's Economic Impact Study to demonstrate regional impact.

Organizational Effectiveness and Fiscal Sustainability

- Implement a transparent Resource Allocation Model aligned with student success goals.
- Adopt multi-year budgeting and Total Cost of Ownership frameworks.
- Scale process automation and digital transformation for operational efficiency.

Organizational Effectiveness and Fiscal Sustainability (continued)

- Strengthen fiscal accountability through dashboards and stewardship expectations.
- Expand revenue through grants, philanthropy, and partnerships to ensure sustainability.

Technology, Data Systems, and Innovation

- Modernize enterprise systems (ERP, CRM, dashboards) for integrated data use.
- Strengthen IT infrastructure, cybersecurity, and Wi-Fi reliability districtwide.
- Expand equitable access to technology and digital literacy for students and employees.

Technology, Data Systems, and Innovation (continued)

- Reduce duplication of technology systems by streamlining processes, consolidating platforms, and improving user training.
- Integrate AI and predictive analytics to enhance enrollment, outreach, and success initiatives.
- Establish districtwide standards and funding priorities for technology-enabled spaces.

Facilities, Infrastructure, and Sustainability

- Align facilities modernization with instructional and workforce priorities.
- Ensure districtwide leadership in maintaining and modernizing College facilities.
- Enhance ADA accessibility, safety, and emergency preparedness.

Facilities, Infrastructure, and Sustainability (continued)

- Integrate sustainability, energy efficiency, and resilience into planning.
- Plan strategically for future bond projects and long-term infrastructure stewardship.
